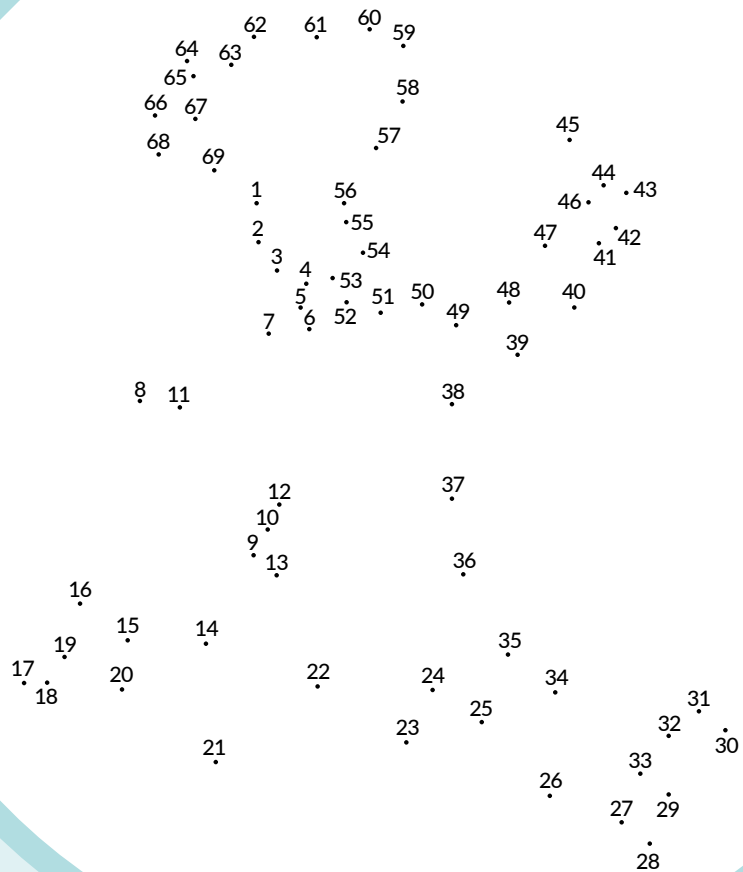

ROCK DRAWINGS IN VALCAMONICA

The rock carvings of Val Camonica (in Lombardy) were Italy's first UNESCO site. These petroglyphs, created over a period of 8,000 years, show scenes of daily life, rituals, and symbols, offering important evidence of the culture and beliefs of ancient alpine peoples.
